Keep Children Safe

In our first week back there has already been a near miss where a careless driver mounted the pavement at speed and was inches away from some of our children. We teach children about safe pedestrian habits from the moment they arrive with us and we reiterate this as they move up the school to year 6. We hope this is something that continues at home as the children get old enough to travel alone. While it is certainly not relevant for everyone, the attached highway code extracts make clear the obligations on drivers to ensure they keep people safe.

144. You **MUST NOT**

- • drive dangerously
- • drive without due care and attention
- • drive without reasonable consideration for other road users.

145. You **MUST NOT** drive on or over a pavement, footpath or bridleway except to gain lawful access to property, or in the case of an emergency.
